



## **Sunscreen and Insect Repellent - Permission**

Sunscreen and insect repellent should be applied to a child at least once at home to test for any allergic reaction. Aerosols, sprays and combined sunscreen/insect repellents are prohibited.

Sunscreen must provide UVB and UVA protection with an SPF of 15 or higher.

Insect repellent may only be used if recommended by public health authorities or requested by a parent/guardian. The repellent must contain a concentration of **30% DEET or less.** Oil of lemon eucalyptus and para-methane products may not be used on children under the age of three.

All sunscreen and insect repellent provided by a parent/guardian must be:

- provided in the original container;
- in an aerosol form (no lotion);
- clearly labeled with the child's full name;
- within the expiration date;
- appropriate for the age of the child; and
- free of nut ingredients
