## 2022-2023 Parking Policies for GBS Student Parking

The Glenview Park District Board of Commissioners is interested in assisting Glenbrook South High School and their parents in finding suitable parking for their vehicles while attending school. The Park Board recognizes that the safety and welfare of Glenview Ice Center patrons and Glenbrook South students requires an official and effective system to control vehicle traffic and parking on Ice Center property.

Because of the safety concern for Ice Center Patrons, GBS students will only be allowed to arrive at the Ice Center parking lot prior to the start of the normal school day, and exit the lot at the conclusion of the normal school day. If a student needs arrive late or leave early for any reason, they must notify the Ice Center office in advance, (call 847 724-2800, M-F 8:30-5:00p) in order to avoid receiving a parking violation and possible loss of parking privileges.

## **Parking Rules**

Any repeated breaking of the following parking rules may lead to revocation of parking privileges without a refund.

- 1. Students will access the parking lot from Hospital Drive and make the first right into the northern most spots of the lot. If all spots in that area are full, students can park in the east spots facing the GBS fields.
- Glenview Community Ice Center staff will monitor the cars parked on a daily basis. Anyone parked in the incorrect parking stall will be given a map showing where to park and be noted by our staff.
- 3. All GBS student vehicles parked on Glenview Community Ice Center property must hang the appropriate Glenview Community Ice Center GBS student parking permit from their rearview mirror so that it is visible through the front and rear windows.
- 4. Unsafe driving of any kind, as determined by Park District Staff, will be considered a violation.
- 5. The speed limit is 10 miles per hour on Glenview Community Ice Center property.
- Only students who have a properly displayed, current GCIC parking permits are authorized to drive or park on school days. Students may not be picked up from or dropped off to their cars by other students.
- 7. Glenview Community Ice Center staff will call parents at the alternate number provided when a parking violation is witnessed.
- 8. Parking permits are nontransferable to other GBS students.
- 9. The Community Ice Center office must be notified in advance if a student will be driving a car other than the one(s) listed on the application
